Dear 5th through 8th Grade Parents:

In 2020 the Washington State Legislature passed Senate Bill 5395 requiring school districts to provide Comprehensive Sexual Health education to students in grade 4-12, in addition to the AIDS Omnibus Act which mandates HIV/AIDS prevention education annually in grades 5^{th} - 8^{th} . Beginning in the 2022-23 school year the law requires schools to provide sexual health education once in either 4^{th} or 5^{th} grade and at least twice in grades 6^{th} through 8^{th} . Green Mountain School will provide sexual health instruction in 5^{th} , 7^{th} and 8^{th} grades. Instruction on these topics will begin on 5/1/23 and will take place during each classes' health time.

6th Grade (HIV/AIDS only)

7th Grade (Sexual health & HIV/AIDS)

8th Grade (Sexual health & HIV/AIDS)

The topic of STDs, HIV/AIDS and sexual health are sensitive. Due to the sensitive nature of this teaching, we have worked hard to create a curriculum that meets OSPI's requirement while considering the values and interests of our district families. Please know our staff is trained to lead discussions that recognize value-based questions. When these questions arise, our teachers do not share their personal opinions. Instead, they will help students recognize that some health, relationship and sexual choices are determined by family and the norms of a culture. Please partner with us in your child's education during this unit of study.

You can preview the videos and curriculum being used by going to our school website under the "For Families" tab. Each grade level curriculum is listed separately, but feel free to preview all materials. These materials will remain posted on our website indefinitely.

If you are choosing to exempt your child(ren) from participating in this instructional program, recognize that students tend to talk about content during the school day. Your child may receive second-hand information. Previewing the curriculum in advance will help you respond to any questions your child may have.

Per the State of Washington parents are required to review the content and presentation materials before opting their child out of the instruction. Students who do not participate in this instruction will go to another location where an alternate health assignment will be completed.

Attached to this letter is an "Opt Out" form that needs to be returned to the school office by 4/28/23. This will allow parents/guardians time to preview the curriculum content.
