Did anyone agree to or feel pressured to agree to a movie they really didn't want to see?

What did it feel like to be in that situation?

Affirmative Consent

Yes Means Yes



Both people clearly and freely agree to engage in an activity.

They have to be awake, aware and able to make decisions.

Consent can be given through words or actions, as long as those words or actions clearly communicate a Yes.

Consent must be ongoing and can be withdrawn at any time.

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Can a person give consent if...

They are asleep?

One or both people have been drinking alcohol or using other drugs?

They are confused or unable to understand what's happening?

They feel pressured or threatened in some way?



Steps of Affirmative Consent

Listen to each other's words and body language.

It's each person's responsibility to make sure that they have consent from the other person.

Express what you like and how you feel.

A person always has the right to say to NO to sexual contact or activity.

Respect each other's boundaries.

It's never OK to try to pressure, trick or threaten another person into sexual contact or activity.
